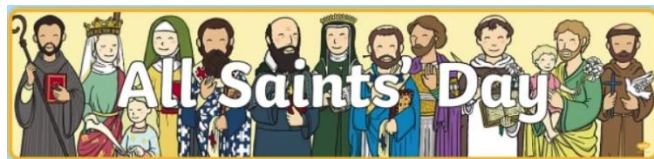


SAINT ANNE'S EPISCOPAL CHURCH
