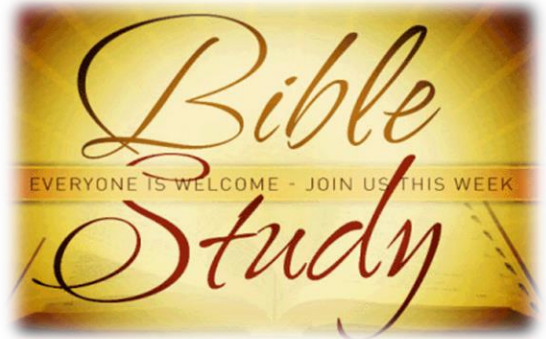
Worship at 8:00AM in the Town Church, 9:30AM Worship at Old Saint Anne's Church followed by refreshments by the gazebo.

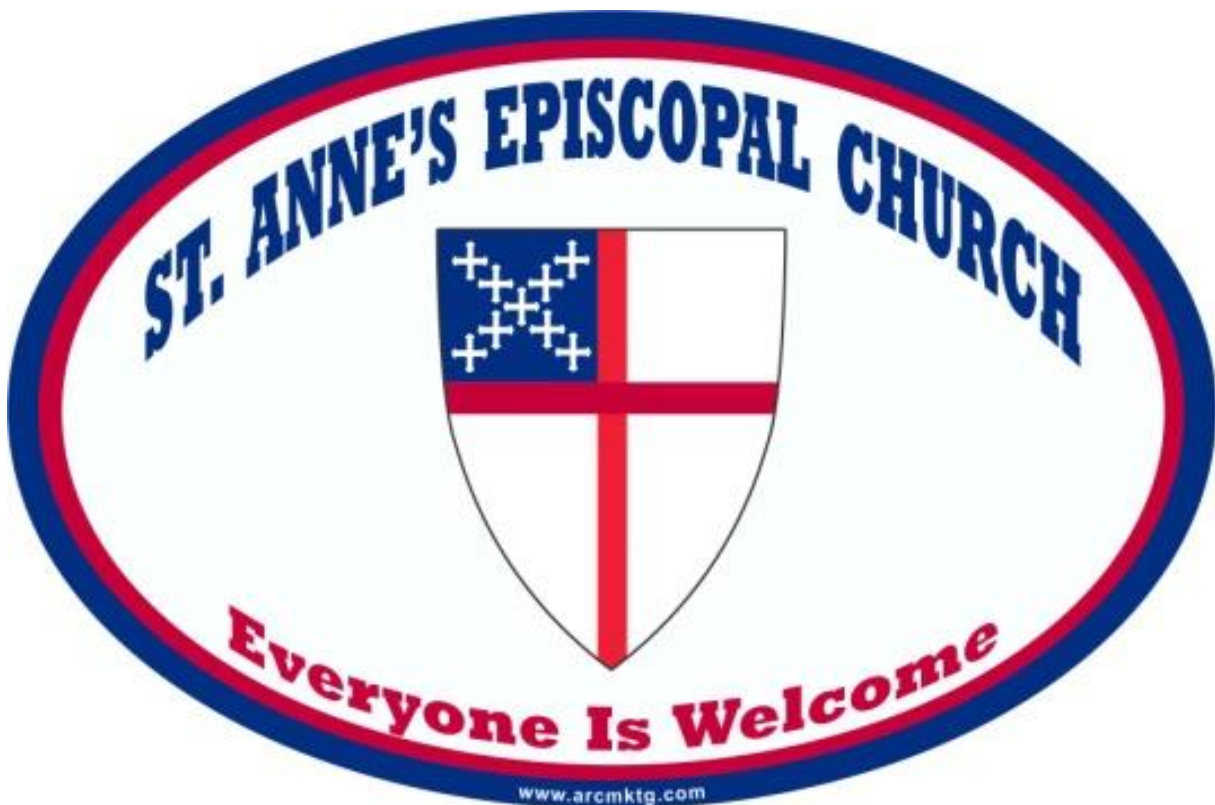

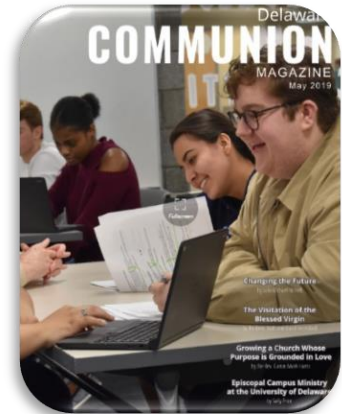
