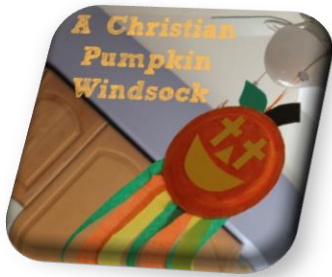
Blessing of the Animals

All creatures great and small are invited to Saint Anne's Church. Bring your pets, pictures of pets and stuffed animals for a blessing.



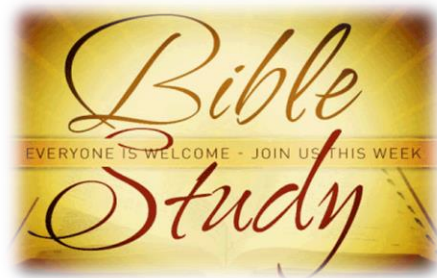

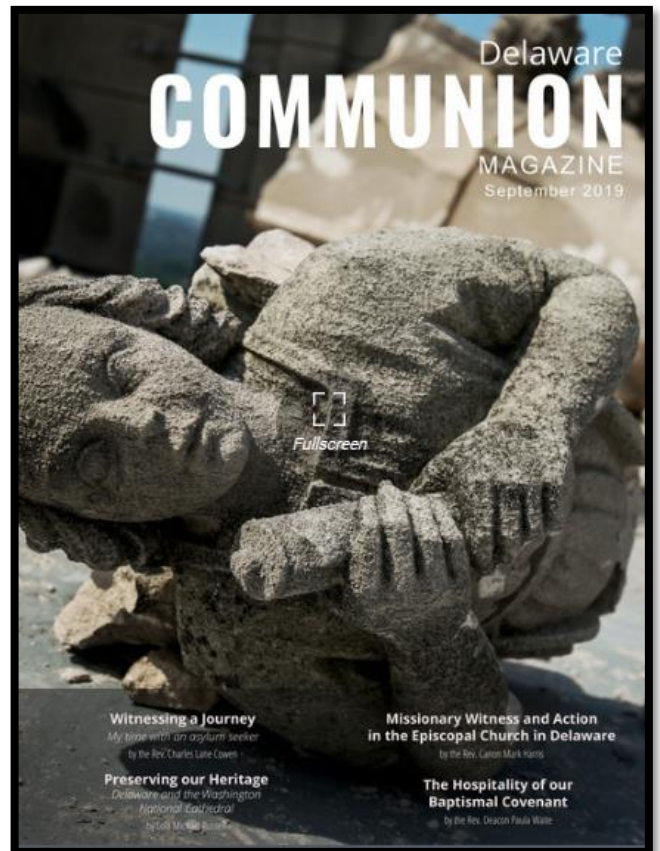
