Thank you for the generous support you and everyone at St. Anne's has provided to Our Daily Bread (ODB). Your kind gift of soups, sauce, canned pasta, canned meats, peanut butter, and beans on 06/21/2022 helps us provide food and comfort to many of our neighbors who would likely go hungry without your help. Your kindness makes a big difference in the lives of many of your neighbors. We are very grateful for all the support your congregation provides ODB and our community.

The need for our services continues to steadily increase each day, so we are constantly exploring new ways to meet the growing needs on our community. The number of hot meals we serve has grown from an average of 2500 a month in December, January and February to an average of 2900 meals a month in March and April. Last month we opened a Community Fridge at our site so our guests can have access to nutritious food whenever they need it. This month we will be reaching out to local businesses to help stock the fridge with some of their surplus products and we are reaching out to more foundations for support. We are grateful for your ongoing support to ensure our neighbors have the food they need to live healthy and productive lives. Our services are needed more than ever, and we need and appreciate your help more than ever too.

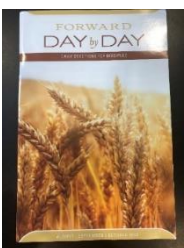

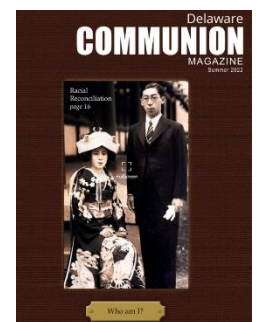
