*Do not be afraid, little flock, for it is
your Father's good pleasure to give
you the kingdom.*

--Luke 12:32

ODB serves lunch weekly on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 12:00 to 1:00 PM and dinner on Mondays through Fridays from 5:00 to 6:00 PM. 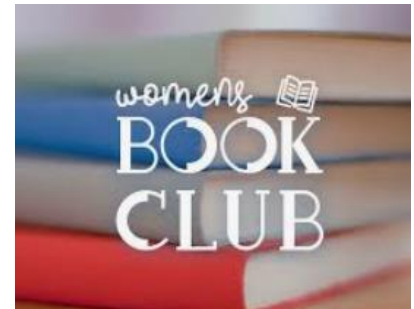

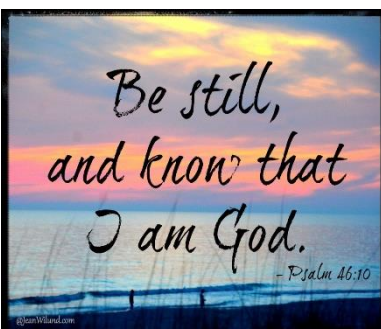
